



Code of Conduct for visiting Educational Groups

The behaviour of all learners whilst visiting Silverstone Museum is the responsibility of their teachers and accompanying adults. We ask that they are supervised and accompanied at all times and that all educational groups follow the minimum staff/student ratio; 1:10 for Primary Schools, Secondary Schools and University groups. Staff must be always visible and identifiable during the visit to Silverstone Museum.

To ensure that everyone has a safe and enjoyable visit we ask that all groups:

- Take responsibility for their own learning.
- Listen to and follow instructions.
- Treat staff, volunteers and other visitors with respect.
- Will not use abusive, intimidating and/or disrespectful language or behaviour.
- Must use mobile phones with respect to other museum visitors.
- Taking part in a workshop session will turn off or switch their mobile phones to silent.
- Leave any spaces you are using as you would wish to find them.
- Leave coats and bags in storage facilities provided.
- Respect the exhibits and displays.
- Refrain from eating or drinking in the exhibition.
- Report any concerns or worries to a member of museum staff.
